2022 INTER-CLUB POOL & DARTS COMPETITION

RULES

Up to 4 members per club, 28 years of age and under on 1st September 2022.

Members must be prepared to show digital membership cards else a £5 fine will be incurred.

One female member to compete in the Girls Singles Event, one male member to compete in the Boys Singles Event and one boy and one girl member to compete in the Mixed Doubles Event.

Members can only compete in one section (either single/doubles or mixed).

Pool Table Rules for 8 Ball Game:

Up to 4 members per club, 28 years of age and under on 1st September 2022.

Members must be prepared to show digital membership cards else a £5 fine will be incurred.

One female member to compete in the Girls Singles Event, one male member to compete in the Boys Singles Event and one boy and one girl member to compete in the Mixed Doubles Event.


Members can only compete in one section (either single/doubles or mixed).

The object of the game is to pot all your group of colored balls and the black ball before your opponent. This game is usually played with 7 red balls, 7 yellow balls, 1 black ball and the white cue ball. The black ball, being the '8' ball. To set up the balls for the start of the game use the triangle provided with most pool tables. The black ball is placed in the middle of the third row and positioned on the spot nearest the back cushion. The formation is as follows: -

Foul Shots:

- Potting the cue ball.
- Playing the cue ball from outside of the baulk (behind the line) area when obliged to do so.
- Potting an opponent's ball except when it's nominated after your opponent has played a foul shot.
- Hitting your opponents' colour or the 8 ball before hitting your own colour.
- Failure to make contact with any ball with the cue ball.
- Failure to have one foot touching the ground whilst playing your shot.
- Failure to perform a fair break.
- Failure to perform a fair shot within 60 seconds of the ball coming to rest.
- Foul shots result in opponent player receiving a free table and being able to pot any colour except the black for 1 shot.
- After a foul, when white ball is placed behind the line you ARE able to shoot back up the table

First decide who will take the first shot by tossing a coin. Player higher up the draw table to call the toss and the other player to call toss for 3rd game if necessary.



The cue ball can be placed anywhere behind the baulk line. This is the line that goes across the table. The player who is breaking shoots the cue ball into the rack of balls ensuring at least two balls hit a cushion. Failure to comply with this, results in a foul and the opponent then re-breaks a re- racked set of balls.

If during the break, a ball is potted then the player at the table continues. The table remains open (no colour belongs to a player) until the first ball is pocketed after the break.

If you pocket the cue ball from the break, your opponent places the cue ball anywhere behind the line but, any balls pocketed will remain pocketed. If you pocket the cue ball at any other time the cue ball can be placed anywhere behind the line.

1 shot on black even after a foul. All rounds sudden death (1 game only). The final best of 3.

If the 8 ball jumps off the table in the process of your shot replace it on the spot. If a colour jumps off pocket it and award two shots to opponent player.

There are many variations of this game both locally and internationally.

The competition will be under exclusive Young Farmers' Clubs supervision, and decisions of all matters and interpretation of the rules will be the responsibility of the chief Steward and Competition Stewards their decisions will be final and binding.

- Who ever's name is higher up the draw table throws for bull first.
- If both come down to double 1, then they are to have 3 goes at the ockie and then it would be closest to the
- Doors and bar open at 6.30pm for 7pm start and if members aren't there by the time the first round is over,

- The draw will be done beforehand.
- Competitors to supply their own darts.
- The "bust" rule will apply i.e. if you score more than you require you revert back to the score required prior to your opponents' last throw.
- No dart to be retrieved from dartboard until the score has been recorded by scorer / referee. Protest after retrieval of dart may not be accepted.
